Luscious Lips



Materials

- any color of medium weight yarn #4
- Hook 5mm
- Yarn Needle
- Scissors

Abbreviations

- Single Crochet (SC)
- Half Double Crochet (HDC)
- Double Crochet (DC)
- Triple Crochet (Trb)
- Chain (ch)
- Stitches (st/sts)
- Slip Stitch (sl st)
- Fasten Off (FO) = slip stitch, cut the yarn and pull it through the loop making a tight knot

PATTERN

Lips

R1: ch 12, SC in the 2nd ch from the hook, HDC, DC, (2) Trb in the same st, DC, SC, DC, (2) Trb in the same st, DC, HDC, SC ch 1, turn upside down to make the bottom lip (13)

R2: SC, HDC, DC in the next 2 sts, Trb, (3) Trb in the same st, Trb, DC in the next 2 sts, HDC, SC, sl st in the corner of the mouth & FO leaving a long tail (13)

Finishing

Use the long tail of the lips to sew it onto your project. Stitch around the outside of the mouth and down the middle between the top and bottom lip. Weave in all yarn tails.

You can also use the luscious lips as an ornament by using the long tail to make a loop at the corner of the mouth or turn it into a fun key chain.

This lip pattern is the same pattern I use for The Crocheted Moon's Nightmare Before Christmas inspired Sally Scarf!
