

# Summer Daisy



## Materials

- “I love this yarn” White & Yellow, medium weight yarn, #4 (Hobby Lobby)
- Hook 4mm
- Yarn Needle

## Abbreviations

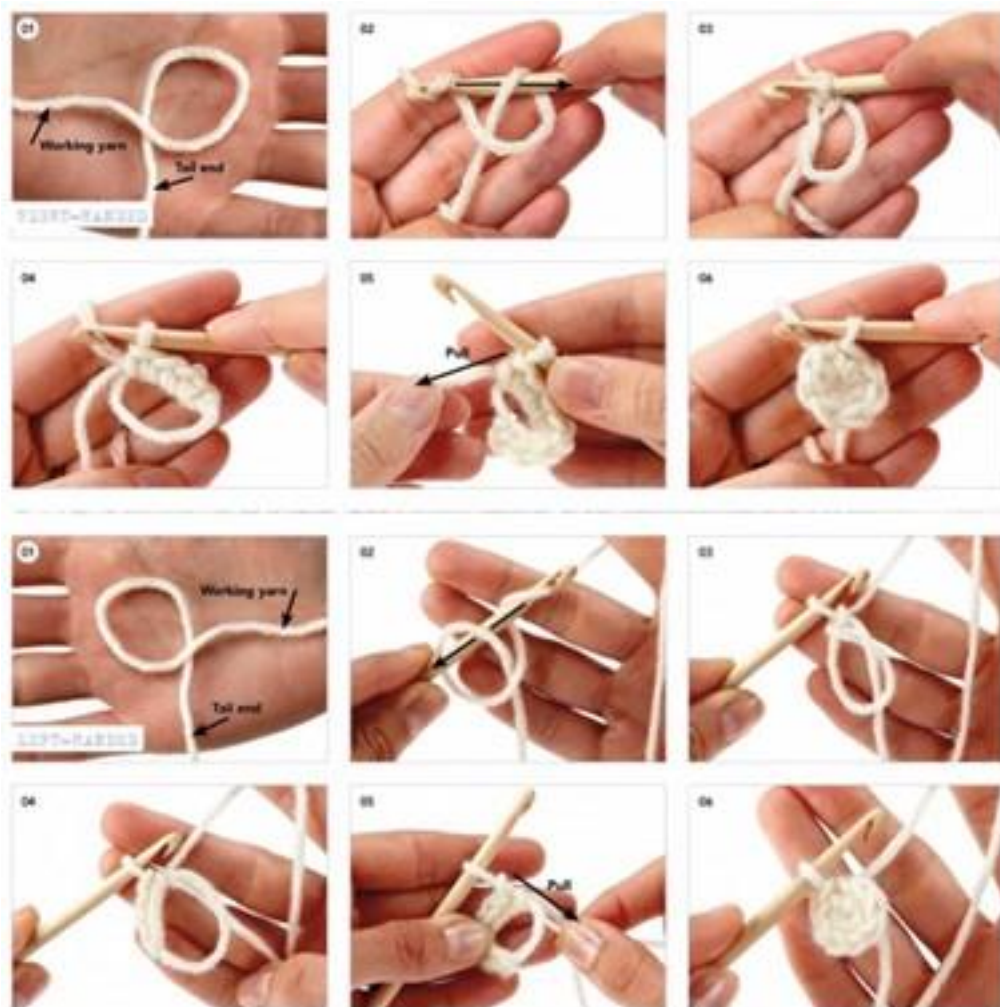
- Single Crochet (SC)
- Half Double Crochet (HDC)
- Chain (ch)
- Increase (inc) = 2 stitches in the same stitch

- Stitches (sts)
- Slip Stitch (sl st)
- Fasten Off (FO) = slip stitch, cut the yarn and pull it through the loop making a tight knot

## PATTERN

### Daisy Center

R1: (Yellow yarn) make a magic ring and SC 6 around the ring  
(6 sts)



R2: 2 SC in each st of the magic ring, sl st in the 1<sup>st</sup> st  
(12 sts)

R3: SC in the same st as the previous sl st, inc, \*SC, inc\* repeat 5 more times, sl st & FO



### Sunflower Petals

1<sup>st</sup> Petal: (white) sl st in the 1<sup>st</sup> st of the daisy's center, ch 6, HDC in the 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from the hook, HDC in the next 4 chs, sl st in the next 2 sts of the center (5 HDC sts)

2<sup>nd</sup> – 11<sup>th</sup> Petals: ch 6 in the st you just sl st in, HDC in the 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from the hook, HDC in the next 4 chs, sl st in the next 2 sts of the center (5 HDC sts)



12<sup>th</sup> Petal: ch 6 in the st you just sl st in, HDC in the 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from the hook, HDC in the next 4 chs, sl st in the next 2 sts of the center  
(5 HDC sts & 12 petals total)

#### Designer's Note:

You can create different sizes of sunflowers by changing the size of your hook and yarn. Make sure the size of the hook matches the gauge of the yarn.
