Harvest Hot Pad

Materials

- Medium weight yarn (4)
- Hook 5mm
- Scissors
- Yarn Needle

Abbreviations

- Chain (ch)
- Stitches (sts)
- Fasten Off (FO) = slip stitch, cut the yarn and pull it through the loop making a tight knot
- Single Crochet (SC)
- Double Crochet (DC)
- Harvest Stitch (HS) = see video tutorial on how to crochet

PATTERN

This pattern is worked in sets of 7 stitches + 3 stitches (this means to chain in multiples of 7 for whatever size you need and then add 3 stitches at the end)

R1: ch 31, SC in the 2nd ch from the hook, SC 29, turn (30 sts)

R2: ch 2, DC in the next 2 sts, skip 2 sts, *HS, skip 2, DC in the next 2 sts*, repeat ** to the end of the row making sure to end with the 2 DC sts, turn (4 harvest sts)

R3-10: repeat row 2 (you should have 10 rows of the harvest stitch). On the last row turn to start row 11.

R11: *SC in the next 2 DC sts, SC in the first puff st, 3 SC in the ch 2 space* repeat ** to the end of the row. Do Not FO.

EDGING

R1: in the last SC st, *SC 2, ch 2, SC 2* (this combination makes the corners of the hot pad). Down the side of the hot pad 2 SC around the side of each DC st (20 sts), *SC 2, ch 2, SC 2*, SC 28 across the bottom, *SC, ch 2, SC 2*. Down the other side of the hot pad 2 SC around the side of each DC st (20 sts), *SC 2, ch 2, SC 2*, SC 28 across the top. Slip stitch in the 1st SC and FO. Weave in all loose tails with your yarn needle.
