

Henrietta's Sunflower Tips



-  **Full Sun** — Plant in a spot with 6–8 hrs of direct sunlight daily for the tallest, happiest blooms.
-  **Sow Deep** — Direct sow seeds 1 inch deep after last frost. Sunflowers dislike being transplanted.
-  **Water Wisely** — Water deeply once a week at the base. Let the top inch of soil dry between waterings.
-  **Space Out** — Giant varieties need 24" apart; dwarf types thrive at 6–12". Give roots room to breathe!
-  **Attract Pollinators** — Leave a few blooms to go to seed — bees and birds will thank you all season.
-  **Deadhead & Harvest** — Snip spent blooms to encourage more flowers, or let seeds dry on the head to harvest.
