# Mini Cauldron



#### **Materials**

- any color of medium weight yarn #4
- Hook 3.5mm
- Yarn Needle
- Scissors

#### **Abbreviations**

- Single Crochet (SC)
- Chain (ch)
- Stitches (st/sts)
- Slip Stitch (sl st)
- Increase (inc) = 2 stitches in the same stitch
- Decrease (dec) = crochet 2 stitches together
- Fasten Off (FO) = slip stitch, cut the yarn and pull it through the loop making a tight knot
- Yarn Over (YO) = wrap the yarn around the hook

### **Stitch Terminology**

<u>Puff Stitch – 5 loops:</u> \*YO, insert your hook in the st, YO and pull up the loop\* 5 times in the same st, YO and pull the yarn through all the loops on the hook.

#### **PATTERN**

# \*\*the body of the pattern will be worked in rounds without slip stitches

**CALDRON** 

R8-9: SC 42

R11-13: SC 39

R15: SC 36

R17: SC 30, sl st in the next st, ch 1

R18: (cauldron lip) SC in the same st as the ch 1, inc, \*SC, inc\* x 14, sl st (45)

R19-20: SC 45, sl st & FO on the last row leaving a long tail.

Roll the cauldron lip over the edge of the body. Use the tail to fasten the lip to the body and make sure it's secure.



#### **FEET**

Turn the cauldron upside down and on the bottom use sewing pins to mark 4 spots that are evenly spaced for the feet. On each spot marked, sl st around the post of the SC st, Puff st around the same post, sl st once again around that same post and FO. Repeat for the other 3 feet.

Weave in all yarn tails.



(4 feet)

#### **RINGS**

Ch 4, sl st in the 1st ch, SC 8 around the inside of the ring, sl st & FO leaving a long tail, repeat for the 2nd ring. Use the tails to sew the rings onto the side of the cauldron making sure they are centered between the

feet on the bottom.
