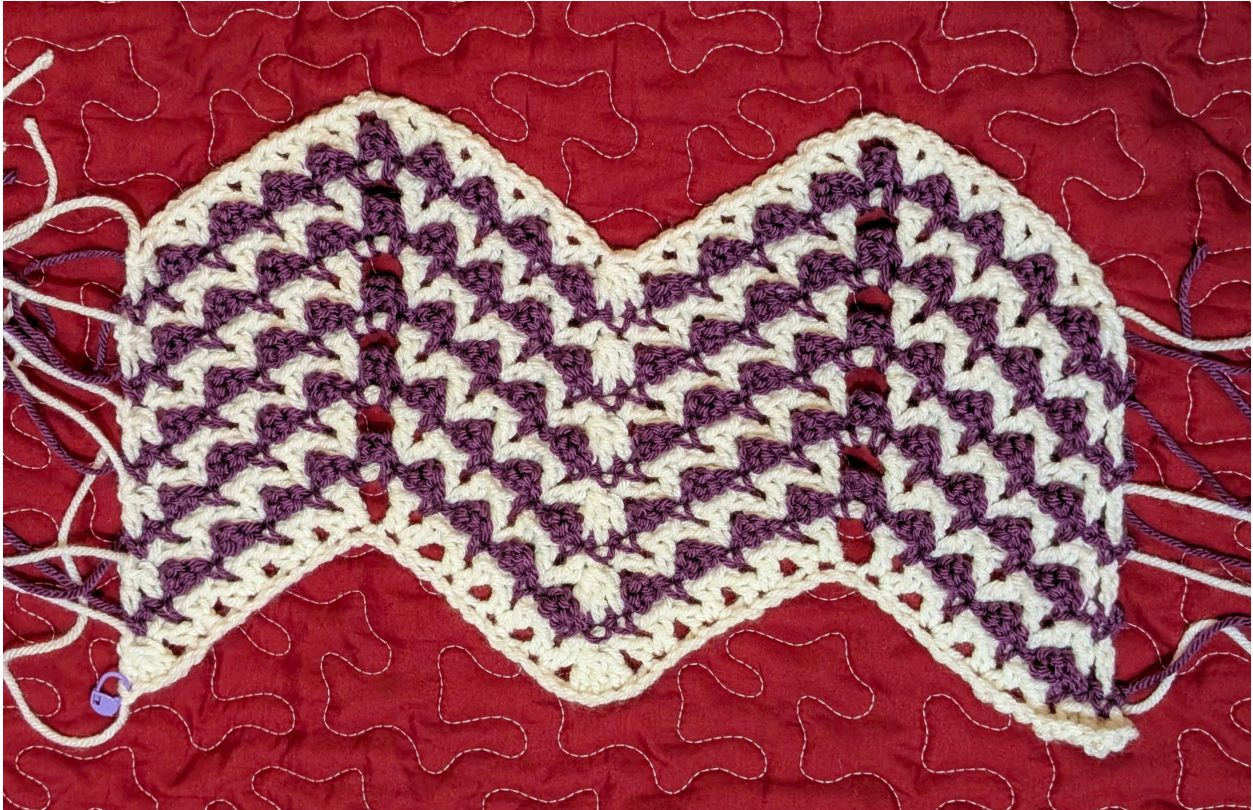


# Chevron Vintage Lace



## Materials

- 2 different colors of of medium weight yarn, #4 (1 skein of each color)
- Hook 5.5mm
- Yarn Needle
- Scissors

## Abbreviations

- Single Crochet (SC)
- Double Crochet (DC)
- Double Decrease (2dctog)
- Triple Double Decrease (3dctog)
- Chain (ch)
- Stitches (sts)
- Slip Stitch (sl st)

- **Fasten Off (FO)**
- **Main Color (MC)**
- **Secondary Color (2nd color)**
- **Right Side of the Fabric (RS)**
- **Wrong Side of the Fabric (WS)**

## Definitions

- **V-st** = *\*DC, ch 1, DC\* all in one stitch*
- **Double Crochet Cluster (Cluster st)** = *\*SC, ch 3, DC in the 3rd ch from the hook\* all in one stitch*
- **Double Decrease (2dctog)** = *YO insert the hook into the next stitch, YO and pull up a loop, YO and pull the yarn through 2 loops on the hook, YO insert the hook into the next stitch, YO and pull up a loop, YO and pull the yarn through 2 loops on the hook, YO and pull the yarn through all 3 of the remaining loops on the hook*
- **Triple Double Decrease (3dctog)** = *YO insert the hook into the next stitch, YO and pull up a loop, YO and pull the yarn through 2 loops on the hook, YO insert the hook into the next stitch, YO and pull up a loop, YO and pull the yarn through 2 loops on the hook, YO insert the hook into the 3rd stitch, YO and pull up a loop, YO and pull the yarn through 2 loops on the hook, YO and pull the yarn through all 4 of the remaining loops on the hook*
- **Fasten Off** = *slip stitch, cut the yarn and pull it through the loop making a tight knot*
- **Right Side of the Fabric** = the front of the piece
- **Wrong Side of the Fabric** = the back of the piece

## **PATTERN**

With MC, chain a multiple of 28 + 4 (ex: 56 chs + 4 chs = 60 chs)

R1: (RS-MC) chain the desired number plus 4 extra chs, DC in the 4th ch from the hook, [skip the next 2 chs, V-st (DC, ch 1, DC) in the next ch] 4 times, ch 3, skip the next ch, \*[V-st, skip the next 2 chs] 4 times, 3dctog in the next 3 chs, [skip the next 2 chs, V-st (DC, ch 1, DC) in the next ch] 4 times\*; repeat from \*\* across to the last 5 chs, skip the next 2 chs, 3dctog in the last 3 chs, sl st & FO.

With the RS still facing you, place a stitch marker in the left hand corner to help you keep track of the right & wrong sides of the piece.

R2: (WS-2nd Color) make a slip knot with the 2nd color, insert the hook into the decrease st of the previous row, YO, pull up a loop, YO and pull the yarn through both of the loops on the hook creating a SC stitch, ch 1, [cluster st (SC, ch 3, DC in the 3rd ch from the hook) in the ch-1 space of the next V-st] 4 times, crochet 2 cluster sts in the ch-3 sp, \*[cluster st in the ch-1 space of the next V-st] 3 times, SC in the ch-1 space of the next V-st, SC in the next triple decrease st, [cluster st in the ch-1 space of the next V-st] 4 times, crochet 2 cluster sts in the ch-3 sp, [cluster st in the ch-1 space of the next V-st] 3 times\*; repeat across to the last V-st, SC in the ch-1 space of the last V-st, ch 1, SC in the last stitch of the row

R3: (RS-MC) sl st in the 1st SC st, 2dctog with the same stitch and the next SC stitch, [V-st in the next SC st] 4 times, ch 3, \*[V-st in the next SC st] 4 times, 3dctog in the next 3 SC stitches, [V-st in the next SC st] 4 times, ch 3, [V-st in the next SC st] 4 times\*; repeat \*\* across to the last 2 SC stitches, 2dctog in the last 2 stitches, sl st & FO

Repeat Rows 2 and 3 for the pattern until you reach your desired length.
